


# CAMP WRIGHT

### OUR MISSION

Camp Wright is a ministry of the Episcopal Diocese of Easton. We provide families from the Eastern Shore of Maryland and beyond an encouraging place to grow, play, and learn. At Camp Wright, children experience days full of games, swimming, crafts, Christian Formation, sports, boating and more. Our program is outdoor based, and we follow the latest guidance from experts to ensure appropriate physical distancing and COVID-19 protocols to promote camper health and safety. Camp Wright is an ACA accredited camp and is licensed by the State of Maryland. All program staff are certified in First Aid, CPR, and AED by the American Red Cross. A licensed health care provider is on site 24 hours a day when Resident Camp is in session. Camp Wright is a tech-free camp and camper cell phones will not be permitted. Campers are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is conducive to our programming, mission, and goals. Behavior that is deemed inappropriate, dangerous, or unmanageable by the Administrative staff is grounds for dismissal from camp. Parents will be contacted as needed.
